Brooks Development Authority names new senior executive

The Brooks Development Authority has hired Timothy R. Bartlett as the authority's new chief operating officer.

He is the former chief operating officer of **Commonwealth Renewable Energy**. In his new role, he will oversee all operational aspects of the Brooks Development Authority (BDA) and will work to ensure the development agency's finances and operations are sound.

Bartlett will report to BDA President and CEO Donald Jakeway.

"Tim brings a wealth of professional experience in finance and management," Jakeway says. "He is just the individual we need to ensure the financial success of our organization."

The BDA is responsible for developing the former Brooks Air Force Base into an economic catalyst on San Antonio's South Side. The authority is also responsible for infrastructure maintenance, development, land use and environmental planning for Brooks City-Base. Tenants at Brooks include the U.S. Air Force, **DPT Laboratories**, the **University of Texas at San Antonio** and the South San Antonio Chamber of Commerce.

In related news, City Council appointed two new members to the 11-person board of directors. John P. Jennings, a senior associate attorney for **Fulbright & Jaworski LLP**, joins the BDA's Planning & Development Committee. Robert A. Larios Sr., who recently retired from the **U.S. Postal Service** as the district director of finance, joins the board as a member of the Finance Committee.
